How many of these autumn signs can you spot when you're out and about?

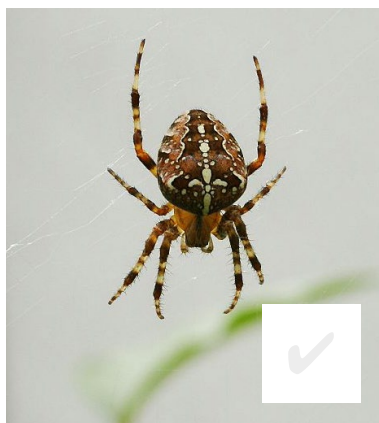

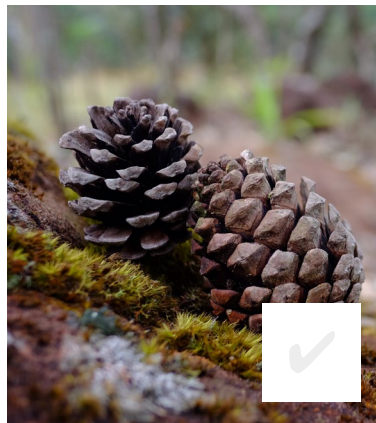
Autumn crocus

These vibrant flowers are a late source of pollen for which six-legged insect?



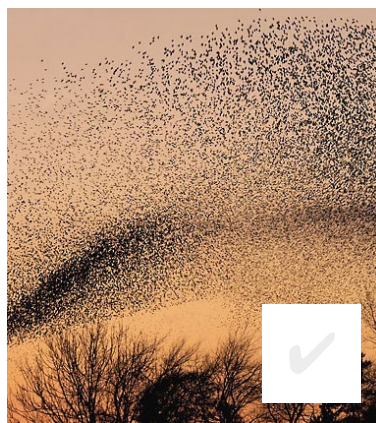
Garden spiders

Keep your eyes peeled for spiral-shaped webs. Can you spot an interesting shape on the spider's back?



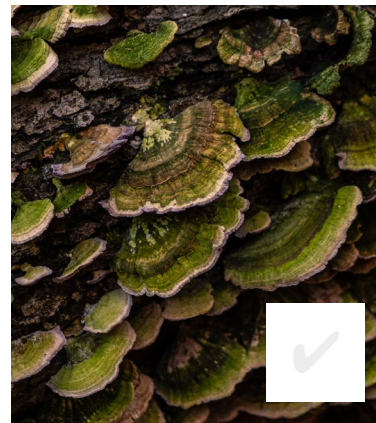
Pine cones

Look closely. Can you see where the seeds are stored?



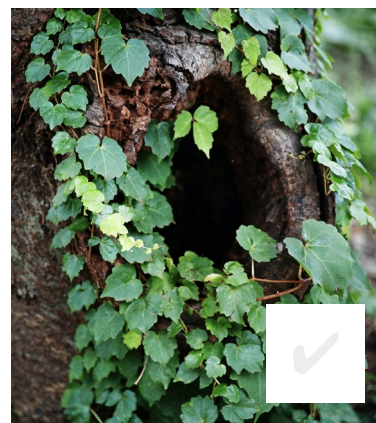
Starlings
