See the 'eyes' on the peacock's wings? These butterflies can flick their wings open quickly to scare off predators such as birds.



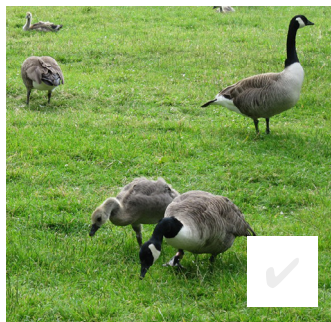
OAK TREE

Look for round-lobed leaves and green acorns. Can you identify other trees by their leaf shapes and seeds?



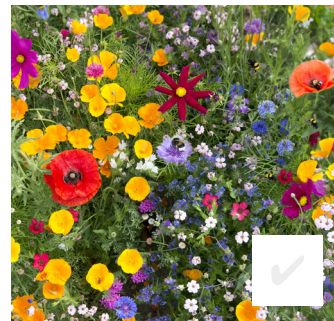
LAVENDER
